<b>Qualitative Analysis</b>		
<p>Bank's leverage ratio was 8.57% as of 30 Sept 2022, decreased by 25bps from previous quarter. It was due to higher Total Exposure by IDR 3.6T, which mainly came from higher Exposure from Reverse Repo by IDR 3.4T. It was compensated by higher Core Capital as a result of increase in current year profit.</p>
